

Opielok bags two

German owner Opielok Bereederungs has moved to strengthen its offshore operations with the addition of two platform supply ships.



The Hamburg-based company will pay \$53m for the two units which will be built at India's Bharati Shipyard.

Following the UT L755 Rolls Royce design, the lengthened twin ships will be designed to operate in harsh North Sea environments. Both units will also have fire fighting capabilities.

No delivery date for the pair has yet been put forward and nobody was available at Opielok's Hamburg offices this morning to shed any light on the deal.

Founded in 1998, Opielok Bereederungs operates a mixed fleet of bulk carriers, containerships and ice classed multipurpose vessels.
